DISCOVER THE PAYS D'AUGE

ACTIVITIES

The Pays d'Auge and the Côte Fleurie are full of activities: horse riding, pony club, golf, bike hire, kayaking, tree climbing, etc. You will find a selection of these in the guides in the library. The Beuvron-en-Auge tourist office (like the village) is well worth a visit. There is also the Lisieux tourist office closer to the house.

WALKS & HIKES

Here are two walks starting from the village of Mesnil-Eudes, lasting approximately 3 hours and 3.5 hours:






TOURISM

A short summary of visits, places to discover & walks:

- ightarrow Go on a tasting visit to one of the cider cellars
- → Stroll around Beuvzon, Bonnebosg, Cambzemez, Beaufouz, Manezbe, and get lost in the back roads, spotting a manor house or stud farm hidden behind a hedge
- → Visit Beuvzon-en-Auge, the postcard village of the Pays d'Auge, with its typical Norman houses and panoramic view from the church of Saint-Michel de Clermont. Head due west towards Beaumont-en-Auge (discover the view from behind the church and the artists' shops)

- → Visit the gardens of the Pays d'Auge and the exhibitions at the Grange aux Dimes in Cambzemez
- → Take a trip back in time at Czèvecœuz-en-Auge castle. Make a series of interesting stops on the way to Falaise: Canon castle, Saint-Pierre en Auge, Vendeuvre castle, William the Conqueror castle, the museum of automata and the museum of civilian victims of war. In Saint-Piezze-en-Auge, visit the Norman vineyard "Les Arpents du Soleil"
- → Admire the château at Saint-Gezmain-de-Livet, the church and its jardin du Curé, then take a detour to the manor house at Coupesarte
- → In *Qisicux*: explore the Carmelite Convent, the Cathedral and the Basilica of Sainte-Thérèse
- → In *Pont l'Evêque*: visit "Calvados experience" for a fun insight into cider and calvados production
- → In Montleuz: Visit the harbour, the art galleries, the picturesque narrow streets, the church of Sainte-Catherine, the museums (Maison Satie, Maison de la Marine, Maison du Vieux Honfleur, Naturospace, etc.), then take the coastal road to *Trouville* and its fish market (seafood tasting on site), *Deauville* and its "planches" (promenade), Houlgate and its shellfish beach or Caboutg and its long jetty with a promenade of almost 2km



The Route du Cidre takes you on a signposted tour of the Pays d'Auge, with its beautiful rolling countryside, fields of apple trees, half-timbered houses, châteaux, stud farms and manor houses, and its most beautiful villages.

Feel free to get lost in one of the countless narrow country roads that criss-cross the cider route and its hedgerows. There are no large fields, but rather a multitude of meadows and orchards grazed by peaceful herds of cows and dashing horses!

Take a detour and discover Beaufour-Druval, Rumesnil, Victot-Ponfol, Saint-Aubin-Lebizay... and stop off at one of the cider producers in the Pays d'Auge, who will be delighted to show you around their farms and offer you the honour of a tasting session.

WHAT WOULD NORMANDY BE WITHOUT THE RAIN?


Don't worry, we've put together some activities to make up for it-a few drops aren't going to deter us!
